

KYKD Radio - God has continued to bless KYKD Radio! Despite some technical challenges, KYKD and its translator stations continue to broadcast the Gospel to the Yukon Kuskokwim Delta region of Alaska. The summer "river ministry" to villages and family fish camps continued this year and the station received 100 additional solar-powered radios to continue that ministry into the future. Currently, they are working on producing a Yup'ik language audio Bible for use on the radio. The staff at KYKD are extremely grateful for SBC's generous financial partnership!
