November Missionary Highlights

Caleb and Candice Wright are SBC Ministry Partners with SEND International. They want to reach the unreached in Southeast Asia with the good news of the Gospel. Wrights are currently on a "Vision Trip" in the region and are within 10% of their support raising goal. This is an exciting step as they explore some of the areas where they feel God is leading them to serve and to take some very practical steps for moving the family over, including looking into language schools, schooling for the kids, housing, and work. Please pray for Caleb and Candice that God will help them on this trip, as they transition, and as they build a team of ministry partners in Southeast Asia.

SOAR International Ministries is busy preparing for our Stuff a Stocking project!! Though they cannot travel to Russia this year due to their war with Ukraine, their partners in Russia and Abkhazia will still be sharing the Gospel and distributing stockings and Bibles to orphans, disabled kids and many other needy children, including expanding Stuff a Stocking to reach Ukrainian refugee children who have fled with their families to the country of Moldova. In January, SOAR plans to take a team to share the Gospel and distribute these stockings and Bibles to these children. They also hope to go into Ukraine this Christmas with the help of partners. Sponsors for 500 more stockings/Bibles are still needed. SOAR missionaries Dick & Kathy Page and Becky Dwinnell are supported by the Chapel.

The November Sunday School offering

will help the Linegars with a Christmas outreach into several villages. The outreach will bring gifts of school supplies, candy, and the Gospel to the villages.


