One of the groups he is working with is the Freedom Business Alliance which seeks to share Christ with the survivors of human slavery and provide jobs for them so they are not tempted to return to the trafficking world. He would love to talk to anyone interested in connecting with this issue. Vicki is involved in Ladies' Bible Studies and community work.

<u>Michael & Nina Schaafsma</u> are serving our Savior through church planting in Italy. In addition to pastoring their church in Punto Luce, Michael has also provided leadership for a church in Bergamo and has begun a Bible study for a group meeting in Cremona. The Schaafsmas have also been responsible for the training courses for an event through the Billy Graham Association. **Pray** for energy and inspiration to continue these ministries in an area severely affected by COVID.

KYKD Radio continues to receive an abundance of challenges and blessings from the Lord. This year the ministry expanded to include a new repeater station in the village of Noorvik, 500 miles north of Bethel. KYKD now broadcasts from 8 transmitter sites in western rural Alaska. We also provide the programming to two stations - in Scammon Bay and in the village of St. Marys. A huge blessing is the recent completion of the Yup'ik Audio Bible, taking 6 years of work involving 24 volunteers, making the entire Word of God available in the spoken native language of this region. We deeply appreciate the prayers and financial partnership of SBC. Please pray that we will be able to wisely build upon God's great blessings and, in His strength, meet the challenges which He allows.
