MARCH MISSIONARY HIGHLIGHTS

KICY Radio in Nome has been on the air since 1960, serving over 40 villages on the Western coast of Alaska and in Russia. They provide a vital connection to Gospel programming as well as locally relevant programming with current events, sports, weather, and broadcast of messages to friends & family. When the people of western Alaska are sleeping, KICY turns its AM antenna westward to Russia, reaching approximately 1,000 miles into the Gospel-starved nation with Christian programming in Russian.

Solid Rock Bible Camp was founded in 1958 by Bert & the late Donna Schultz. Their efforts, with the help of several volunteers, successfully laid the spiritual foundations for a camp & its people who are "built on the Solid Rock." Under the current leadership, SRBC serves as a vibrant outreach to hundreds of kids each year. The camp also serves the community through retreats & annual events. At SRBC, God's Word & the Gospel are taught and lives are eternally changed.

Kevin & Donna Spence serve with Training Leaders International, which focuses on sending teachers, training leaders, and strengthening the church around the world. Kevin recently went with a team to Ghana to meet with several Ghanaian pastors and to do a mini course in Isaiah and the Prophets. He also had the blessing of meeting with refugee pastors from the Ivory Coast and Liberia.
