March Mission's Highlights

KICY Radio in Nome has been on the air since 1960, serving over 40 villages on the Western coast of Alaska as well as Russia. In Alaska, KICY broadcasts two distinct programs, one on AM (50,000 watts) and the other on FM (1,000 watts). They provide a vital connection to Gospel programming as well as locally relevant programming with current events, sports, weather and broadcast of messages to friends and family. When the people of western Alaska are sleeping from 11 pm to 4 am, KICY turns its AM antennae westward to Russia, reaching approximately 1,000 miles into the Gospel-starved nation with Christian programming in Russian.

Solid Rock Bible Camp was founded in 1958 by Bert and Donna Schultz. Their efforts, with the help of several volunteers, successfully laid the spiritual foundations for a camp and its people who are "built on the Solid Rock". Under the current leadership of Ted and Valerie McKenney, SRBC serves as a vibrant outreach to hundreds of kids each year. The camp also serves the community through retreats and annual events. At SRBC, God's Word and the Gospel are taught and lives are eternally changed.
