Ryan & Rebecca Stowell serve with CORD Ministries in Thailand. The Stowells minister at Seed of Hope, a Christian based dorm for Akha children. Because many Akha people are not Thai citizens they live in poverty & have difficulty accessing education. These children are at higher risk of being sold into child labor, slavery, or prostitution. The goal of Seed of Hope is to lead students to a relationship with God through Jesus Christ, to give them access to public & college education, & to develop sustainable practices through planting crops, raising animals, & creating business opportunities. www.seedofhopethailand.org Ron & Kim Linegar, as farmers & ranchers, reach out to Indonesia. The Christian church in Indonesia is very persecuted. However, God has provided people who are seeking Biblical truth where the Lineaars minister. Many of these people don't know what a personal relationship with Christ means. The Linegars provide pastoral education, Bible studies, VBS, English classes, & outreach. They also train lay leaders, disciple nursing students, & raise teams to evangelize. Max Schaafsma is serving the Lord in Milan, Italy through CEDE Sports. Please pray for God to use him greatly as he seeks to build Christ-centered relationships in the sports world. Pray also for the church he pastors, Punto Luce (Point of Light), that God may encourage the believers there to shine the light of Christ to their community. Pray for the youth to grow in their faith and boldness in sharing the good news of salvation with their friends.


