August Mission Spotlights

Don & Ilene Nagle are directors of Northern Light Ministries serving church planters in three states of Mexico. NLM's motto is "Partnering, Preparing, Sending & Serving." The seminary in Papalote prepares men and women to "go into all the world". In partnership with the Baja California Papalote church 9 families have been sent as missionary church planters, 6 churches established, and 4 new mission works begun. Many souls have come to Christ through active evangelism, compassion ministries, and through family contact. Immediate follow-up discipleship with active participation in ministry is key in establishing deep roots.

Mike & Ranada Hassemer serve with Arctic Barnabas Ministries in Kenai. The mission of ABM is to strengthen and encourage pastor and missionary families to effectively advance the Gospel of Jesus Christ throughout Alaska and Northern Canada. Ministry families in the remote parts of the arctic need to be physically and spiritually healthy to be effective ministers of the Gospel. ABM comes alongside ministry families providing retreats, help with projects, pulpit supply, and counsel through fellowship. Besides providing pastoral care and leading work projects, Mike oversees all the fundraising activities of ABM. Ranada provides care to moms and wives through fellowship, hosting families, shopping for supplies and sending regular notes of encouragement.
