AUGUST MISSION SPOTLIGHTS

Don & Ilene Nagle are directors of Northern Light Ministries in Mexico. NLM's motto is "Partnering, Preparing, Sending & Serving." The seminary in Papalote prepares men & women to "go into all the world". Nine families have been sent as missionary church planters, 7 churches established & 4 new mission works begun. Two of the churches have begun work on establishing new churches. Many have come to Christ through evangelism, compassion ministries & family contact. Immediate follow up discipleship with participation in ministry is key in establishing deep roots. Ilene made a short ministry trip back to Mexico while Don was recovering from surgery in OR. Continue to pray for Don as he makes progress with his prosthetic leg, and is getting along with a cane. Both Don & Ilene expect to head back to Mexico mid-September.

Love INC is a network of churches in the community that link church ministries & volunteers to people in need. It is a cooperative effort between churches & community agencies to provide effective help for the disadvantaged. It is a vehicle that helps churches fulfill their Biblical mandate to reach out to the poor & needy.

Mike & Ranada Hassemer serve with Arctic Barnabas Ministries in Kenai. The mission of ABM is to strengthen & encourage pastor & missionary families to effectively advance the Gospel of Jesus Christ throughout Alaska & Northern Canada. Ministry families in the remote parts of the arctic need to be physically & spiritually healthy to be effective ministers of the Gospel. ABM comes alongside ministry families providing retreats, help with projects, pulpit supply & counsel through fellowship. Besides providing pastoral care & leading work projects, Mike oversees fundraising activities of ABM. Ranada provides care to moms & wives through fellowship, hosting families, shopping for supplies & encouragement.
