## Soldotna Bible Chapel Mission Statement



## **September Mission's Highlights** John Musgrove and Sasha & Yulia Zibarov

John grew up in Soldotna. In 1986 he joined the staff of Campus Crusade and has been with them in Ukraine since 1995. He leads a team that develops student leaders and volunteers so that they can build student movements of prayer, evangelism, and discipleship. Sasha and Yulia became missionaries with Campus Crusade in 2002. This year they celebrated their 15th year of being on staff. They have served in the student & operations ministry. In 2015 Sasha was chosen to be the National Team leader. Yulia as part of the National Team which focuses on care and support of the staff women.

Stephen and Esther Napier teach at Global Theological Seminary in Uganda training national pastors from across East Africa. A focus of their work has also been to help pastors start village schools and training programs in their local churches. Stephen currently serves as the Regional Director of Africa for Global Outreach, overseeing their work in 13 countries, as well as, training all new missionaries sent out by Global Outreach to 44 countries worldwide. In addition to serving abroad, several times a year Stephen teaches out at the Moravian Seminary in Bethel, Alaska.
