September Ministry Partner Highlights

John Musgrove and Sasha & Yulia Zibarov serve the Lord through Campus Crusade for Christ in Ukraine. Their goal is to build spiritual movements in every city, so that every non-Christian will have an opportunity to know someone who truly follows Jesus Christ. Sasha serves as the National Team Leader for Ukraine. Yulia serves as associate team leader with the Budapest Team reaching Ukrainian refugees in Budapest, Hungary. The ministry strives to reach all divisions of Ukrainian society: students. military, professionals, teachers, churches, & athletes. Since the war started, the Zibarov's and John have been living in the Diosd, Hungary, a suburb of Budapest. Sasha and Yulia make trips into Ukraine on a monthly basis. John, along with reaching Ukrainian refugees in Hungary, will also be part of a new team focusing on partner development so that Ukrainian teams and ministries can become self sustainable.

<u>Stephen and Esther Napier</u> teach at Global Theological Seminary in Uganda, training national pastors

from across East Africa. A focus of their work has also been to help pastors start village schools and training programs in their local churches. Stephen currently serves as the regional director of Africa for Global Outreach, overseeing their work in 13 countries, as well as training new missionaries sent out by Global Outreach to 44 countries worldwide. In addition to serving abroad, Stephen teaches at the Moravian Seminary in Bethel, AK, several times a year.

September's Sunday School offering is going toward John Musgrove's ministry to provide hospitality items for Ukrainian refugees.
