September Mission's Highlights John Musgrove and Sasha & Yulia Zibarov

John grew up in Soldotna. In 1986 he joined the staff of Campus Crusade and has been with them in Ukraine since 1995. He leads a team that develops student leaders and volunteers so that they can build student movements of prayer, evangelism, and discipleship.
