

July Mission Spotlights

Ryan & Rebecca Stowell serve with CORD Ministries in Thailand. The Stowells minister at Seed of Hope, a Christian based dorm for Akha children. Because many Akha people are not Thai citizens they live in poverty & have difficulty accessing education. These children are at higher risk of being sold into child labor, slavery, or prostitution. The goal of Seed of Hope is to lead students to a relationship with God through Jesus Christ, to give them access to public & college education, & to a development of sustainable practices through planting crops, raising animals, & creating business opportunities. www.seedofhopethailand.org

Ron & Kim Linegar, as farmers & ranchers, reach out to Indonesia. The Christian church in Indonesia is very persecuted. However, God has provided people who are seeking Biblical truth where the Linegars minister. Many of these people don't know what a personal relationship with Christ means. The Linegars provide pastoral education, Bible studies, VBS, English classes, & outreach. They also train lay leaders, disciple nursing students, & raise teams to evangelize.

<u>Max Schaafsma</u> ministers in Italy through Cede Sports/International Sports Ministry. His purpose is to build relational bridges to bring people to Christ. He also works closely with the ministry of Punto Luce Church, who are rejoicing that the Supreme Court ruled in favor of letting them meet after having been closed by the local government. Pray for guidance as they make plans for summer ministries that will conform to new health laws resulting from the impacts of COVID-19.
